## Report for the LRTA Mixed Handicap Doubles 2024

The first group was won by Candida Nicholls and Peter Mawson, who didn't lose a match. Our sponsor, Chris Halliwell with his partner Caroline MacDowell were runners up in the group and also qualified for the Knockout. The second group featured the new pairing of Georgie Ingham and George Fowler. It was George's railroad (thanks to John Lumley's great coaching!) that proved too difficult to many of his opponents and with his steady partner, they didn't lose a match in the group. They together with the local pair of Alex Garside and Simon de Halpert qualified for the Knockout.
